ServSafe is the Educational Foundation's food safety program sponsored by Sysco-Syracuse and Cornell Cooperative Extension of Onondaga & Monroe County. It centers on the foodservice leader's role in measuring risks, setting policies, and training and supervising employees.

Additional information covered: personal hygiene, HACCP, the flow of food – from purchasing to reheating, designing facilities and choosing equipment, sanitizing, and controlling pests, to name a few. The information the course provides is practical and directly applicable to your operation.

ServSafe includes employee study guides, videos, leader's guide, and other teaching aids for foodservice leaders to use. Those who successfully complete the ServSafe course and examination receive a certificate. In addition, the course fulfills Continuing Education Credits (CEU) requirements for many food-related associations and programs.

## **DIRECTIONS TO OUR OFFICE:**

### **From the North:**

Traveling South on I-81, take the North Clinton Street Exit.  
At the stoplight (on Clinton Street) turn right onto Herald Place.  
Cornell Cooperative Extension office is 1/2 block up on the right (yellow brick building).  
Turn into free parking lot on your right just before the building.

### **From the Thruway (East & West):**

Take Exit 36 off the NYS Thruway to Route 81 South.  
Follow the directions traveling from the North.

### **From the West:**

Take Route 695 to I-690 East past the NYS Fairgrounds.  
Exit I-690 at West Genesee Street.  
At stop light at end of ramp, turn left onto West Genesee Street.  
Go to 2nd stoplight; turn left (North Franklin Street).  
At 2nd stoplight turn right onto Herald Place.  
Cornell Cooperative Extension office is yellow brick building on the left.  
Free parking lot is on right side of building.

### **From the East:**

Take I-690 west to the West Street Exit  
Turn left onto West Fayette Street  
At light, turn left onto one-way ramp. Stay in right lane, follow signs to Herald Place.  
Stay in right lane and at light go straight across Franklin Street.  
Cornell Cooperative Extension office is yellow brick building on the left. Free parking to right of building.

### **From the South:**

Take Route 81 North to I-690 West-to-West Street Exit.  
Turn left onto West Fayette Street  
at light, turn left onto one-way ramp. Stay in right lane, follow signs to Herald Place.  
Stay in right lane and at light go straight across Franklin Street.  
Cornell Cooperative Extension office is yellow brick building on the left. Free parking to right of building.

## **Directions from our office:**

### **Destinations North via Route 81:**

From parking lot, turn right onto Herald Place.

At stoplight, turn right onto North Franklin Street.  
Go straight; pass under the I-690 overpass, and over Route 81 (stay in left lane).  
Turn left onto Route 81.

### **Destinations East, West & South:**

From parking lot, turn right onto Herald Place.  
Turn left onto North Franklin Street.  
Go through three lights to Erie Blvd.  
Turn right onto Erie Blvd. - stay in right lane (one block). Turn right onto I-690 - Take I-690 East or I-690 West.  
To go to Route 81 South - take the I-690 east ramp and follow signs to Route 81 South.

## **From NYS Thruway Exit 46**

Take 390 to the North.

Do not exit at the first East Henrietta Road you come upon

At the large fork in the expressway, stay on 390 (bear left); do not veer to the right onto 590

Exit at East Henrietta Road - the first exit after the large fork

Turn right (North) on East Henrietta Road

You will pass Monroe Community Hospital on your left.

Cross Westfall Road

Bear right at the fork onto South Avenue

Cross Elmwood Avenue

Turn right at Highland Avenue

Cornell Cooperative Extension is the first building on the right, past the park area.

There is plenty of parking behind the building.

## **From NYS Thruway Exit 45 (coming from the East)**

Take 490 to the West

Exit at Goodman Street

Turn left (South)

Cross Clinton Avenue

Turn right on Highland Avenue

Cornell Cooperative Extension is the brick building on the left, after the private homes.

There is plenty of parking behind the building

## **From NYS Thruway Exit 47 (coming from the West)**

Take 490 to the East

Stay on 490 when it intersects with 390

Do not exit 490 at the Inner Loop

Exit at Goodman Street

Turn right onto Goodman St.

Cross Clinton Avenue

Turn right on Highland Avenue

Cornell Cooperative Extension is the brick building on the left, after the private homes.

There is plenty of parking behind the building

## **From Route 104 (coming from the North - either East or West)**

Take 590 South

Exit at Highland Avenue, West

Follow Highland Avenue past numerous intersections (several miles)

Just past Goodman Street, Cornell Cooperative Extension is the brick building on the left, after the private homes. There is plenty of parking behind the building.
