

Washington County Tractor & ATV Safety Courses

The course is generally held during the week of April school vacation (great thing for your teens to do) and then if need be in June or July. Please contact the office to find out about the dates and location.

In addition to the traditional 4-H Tractor Certification, Washington County now offers 4-H Community ATV Safety as part of the course. The ATV segment of the course is not a certification course and does NOT meet the DMV requirements for licensure. The main focus of the program is to develop safety behaviors and to teach youth about avoiding dangerous situations. These include helmet use, proper use of ATVs, riding single, and impacts of ATVs on the environment.

There is a split level fee for the program. The fee is \$10 for enrolled 4-H members within Washington County. Non-members and residents of other counties are \$15. The fee includes the NYS Tractor Certification manual which is required for the course. Students are required to provide their own lunch and you must attend all sessions and pass the exams to receive the certificate. You from Washington, Warren, and Saratoga Counties are welcome to attend.
