



Making a 4-H Club Banner



Club Banners are great for your club to have. The club banner can be used throughout the 4-H Year, the following are some examples of where it can be displayed:

- ❑ At the 4-H Fair: A new club banner, or the same banner should hang in your club booth each year at the fair. (Please note: a Club Banner may only be entered once for judging; unless you have created a new banner that year).
- ❑ Opening Ceremonies at the 4-H Fair: 2 or 3 youth representatives from each club are invited to take part in opening ceremonies by walking in a procession with all of the 4-H Clubs to the stage and remaining on stage for the entire ceremony.
- ❑ Community Service Projects: When your club performs community service around the county, be sure to display your club banner to let people know who you are.
- ❑ New York State Fair: If your club banner is selected, it will be transported to and judged at the NYS Fair.
- ❑ 4-H Club Meetings: Hang at your weekly or monthly meetings.

Banner Requirements:

Banner should:

- ❑ Be than 6' wide and 4' long
- ❑ Say Cornell Cooperative Extension of Putnam County/4-H Youth Development (Can abbreviate Cornell Coop. Ext. of Put. County or CCE of PC; if possible 4-H Youth Development)
- ❑ Have a 4-H Clover
- ❑ Have the name of your 4-H Club
- ❑ Reflect the focus of your club
- ❑ List the member's names if possible (first names only)
- ❑ Reflect the 4-H Fair Theme (only if you plan to make a new banner each year).
